



1. Take off the lid.



2. Make sure the urine goes to the jerry can and the faeces enters the pit.



3. Anal cleansing water should enter the pit.



4. Add 1-2 cups or handfuls of soil/ash to the pit after each use.



5. Replace the lid.



6. Wash hands with soap after each use.

Important information :

- Add leaves or straw to the pit on a regular basis to get a good compost.
- If there are odors or flies:
 - Add more soil/ash to the pit;
 - Use less water;
 - Verify that the fly screen is not broken;
 - Adding a roof makes the cabin darker and discourages flies from rising from the pit.
- It can be necessary from time to time to even-out the cone of faeces that will form in the pit.
- When the first pit is full, add a decent layer of soil on top, and place the slab on the second pit. The first pit can be emptied after 12 months of composting.
