



Single vault UDDT with mobile containers for faeces collection

The full containers are covered with fly screen and are stored in the vault.



Glenda Sol briefs the participants for the practical re-use exercise.

At the bottom is a container with dried feaces (1 year) and a container with urine (1 month storage).



Two participants prepare the field by digging holes for the seeds. The field is owned by the owners of the UDDT (1 big family). Seeds included squash, string beans and eggplant.



Dried faeces are used as soil conditioner prior to sowing.



Dried feaces are thrown into the seed hole.



Some people prefer to use a shovel for moving dried faeces.



Putting the seeds into the seed hole.



Watering the seeds (water only).



Urine is taken from the storage container and dilluted with water



Diluted urine is applied as fertilizer on ornamental plants
