eThekwini commitments

- "To ensure that one, principal, accountable institution takes clear leadership of the national sanitation portfolio; establish one coordinating body with specific responsibility for sanitation and hygiene, involving all stakeholders..." (Commitment 5);
- "To establish, review, update and adopt national sanitation and hygiene policies... to establish one national plan ... and ... ensure national sanitation programs are on track" (Commitment 3).


