

Inadequate financing of sanitation activities

Lessons Learnt

 VHT system is key to the success and sustainability of sanitation in households (regular follow ups, data collection, reporting)



Sanitation promotion in child headed house holds is a challenge.

Role of public sector;

- Demand creation raise awareness, inform on range of sanitation options, promote learning & sharing leading to replication and scale up, enforcement of sanitary practices.
- Regulation enabling environment (clear direction with good strategies), licensing, legal/policy/institutional frame work, standards, unethical conduct, partnership with IPs/NGOs, sustainability modalities

Role of public sector.....

- Monitoring & Evaluation quality, impact, improvements e.g. along sanitation ladder, consumer/entrepreneurs concerns, breach of contracts.
- Quality Assurance & Control –
 products/standards, services (empting and discharge), safe treatment and disposal, workmanship.
- Market research segregation, scoping of potentials, business model development & support, building evidence based consensus.
