It is well known that stimulating the demand for sustainable sanitation will put a high pressure on the supply side of components, such as toilets, pipes, latrines, as well as qualified server providers.



there is a need to organise a suitable supply chain, identifying companies and suppliers that could cover the demand.







A supply chain or logistics network is a system of organisations, people, technology, activities, information and resources involved in moving a product or service from supplier to customer.

The importance of the supply chain is to ensure that the final end users are provided with options of getting easy access to the materials and products needed for the proper practice of sustainable sanitation



To be able to contact the sourcing agency for the implementation of sanitation programs and projects is compulsory for the success; otherwise any planning effort will be useless.






WP5: Regional identification of possible suppliers / actors

The main objective of this work package, which started after the identification of technical and non-technical requirements, was to identify and map suppliers of sanitation services, components and equipments, as well as organisations related to the implementation of sanitation projects and programmes, such as donors, capacity building institutions, NGOs, CBOs, Universities, etc.

The main idea behind was the development of a data base of key capacities for Africa, offering an African marketing information system, which is now available for the sanitation planners, authorities and individuals involved in sanitation planning and implementation.

3. Implemented methodology

1. Identification of key factors


The technical factors were related to the various sanitation systems, particularly the technical components needed for the constructions of sanitation facilities, for instance: toilets, pipes, reactors, tanks, etc. The non-technical factors were identified to include the financial, social, legal, economic and technical (e.g. technical counselling, research & training) aspects of the carrying out of such programmes.

2. Mapping the companies and organisations

To effectively achieve this mapping out, questionnaires were made and distributed among the partners of the NETSSAF project who in turn distributed these questionnaires to companies and organisations previously identified located not only in West Africa, but around the world.


3. Launch of the online sanitation database
