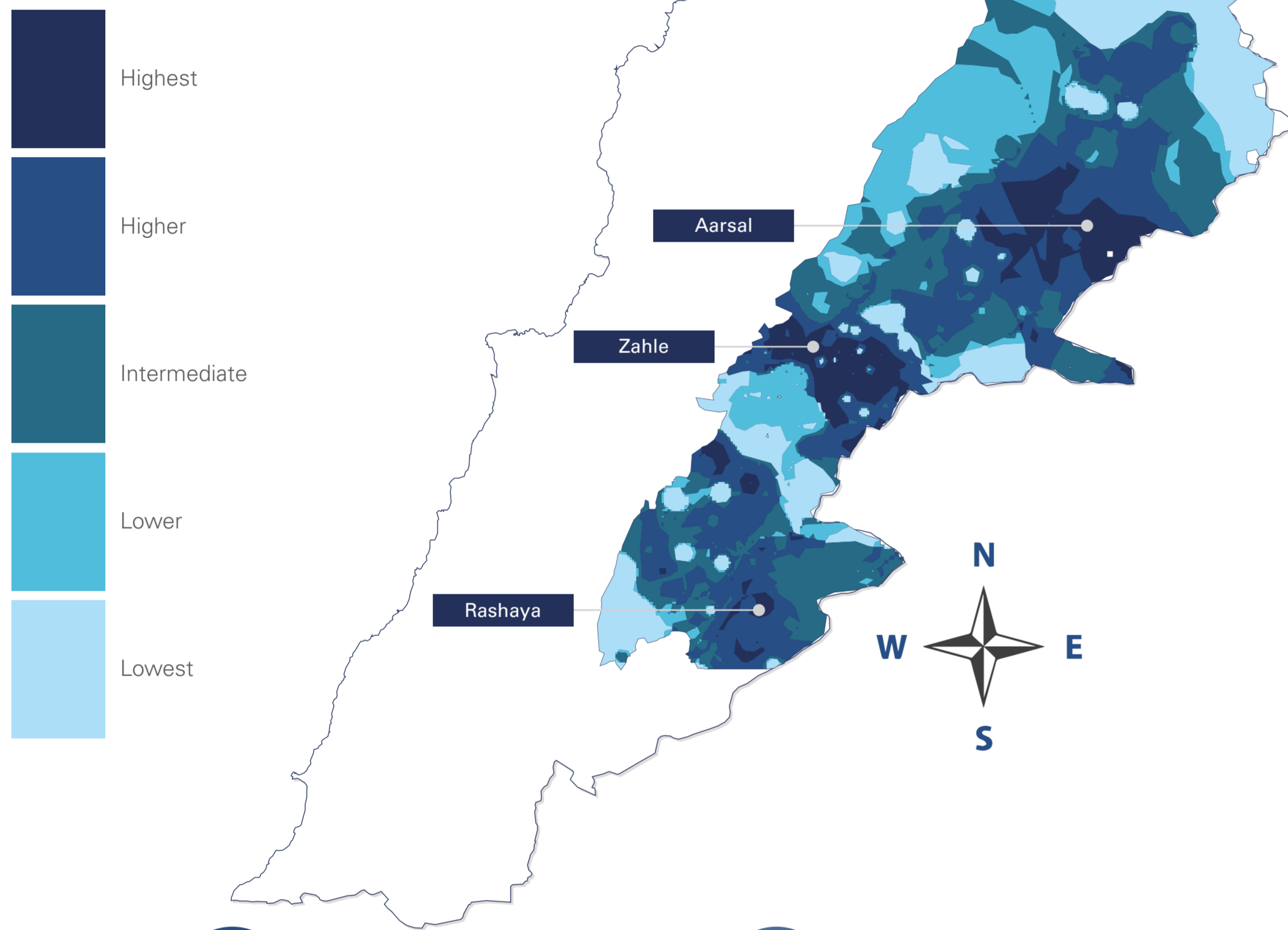
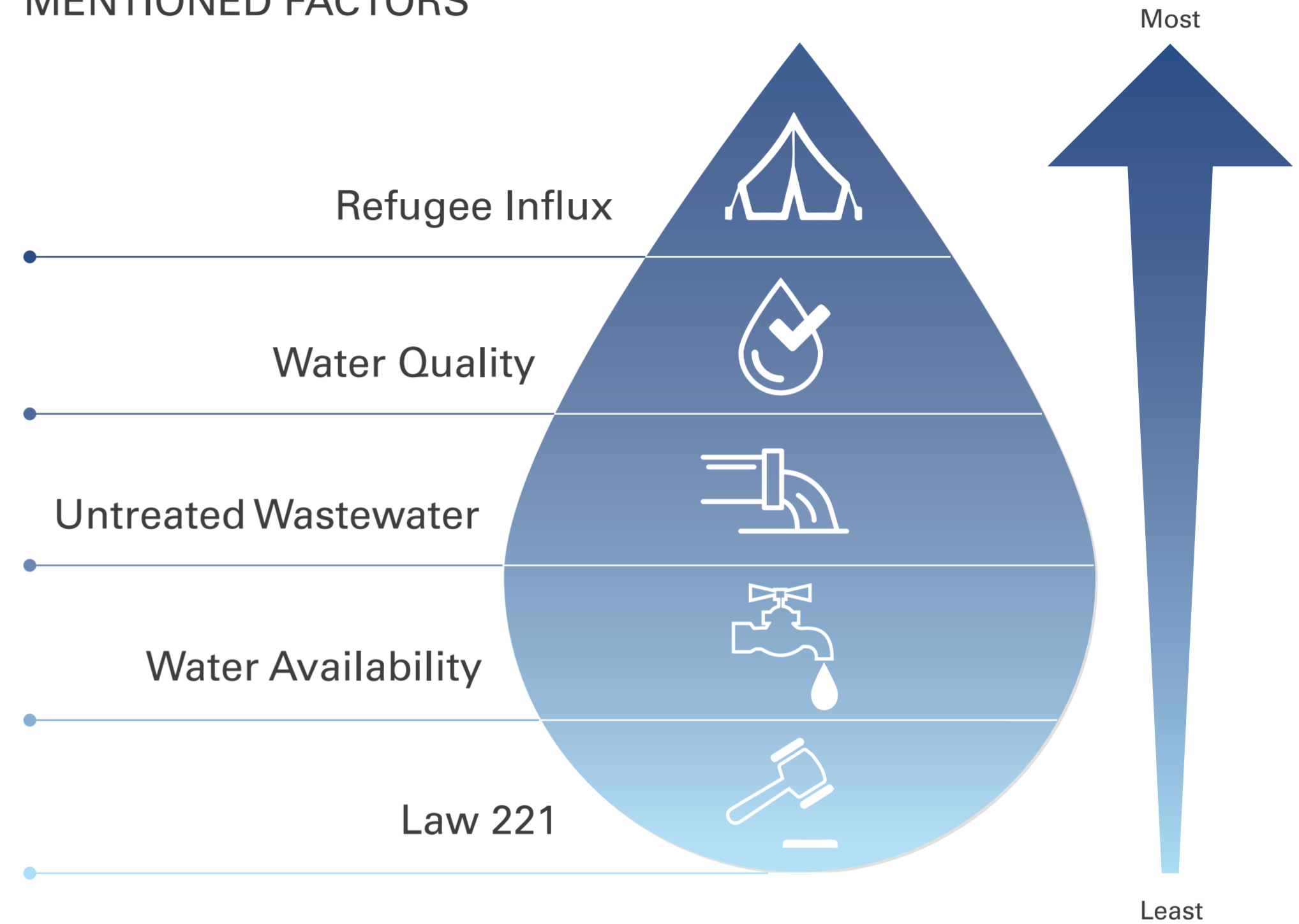


PREDISPOSITION TO WATER CONFLICT IN THE BEKAA, LEBANON

Citizens are digging wells at depths ranging from 50m to 60m turning them into sanitary pits; this has raised concern over infiltration of wastewater to other groundwater wells.
