Background

- ▶ Implementation of CBS Service packages progress from 2003 – 2011 :
: more than 800 locations throughout Indonesia
- ▶ Massive scale of CBS Implementations
: from Gol and Other Donor
- ▶ CBS Service packages implemented approaching MDGs
: more than 8000 units in 2014

Locations of Service package implementation

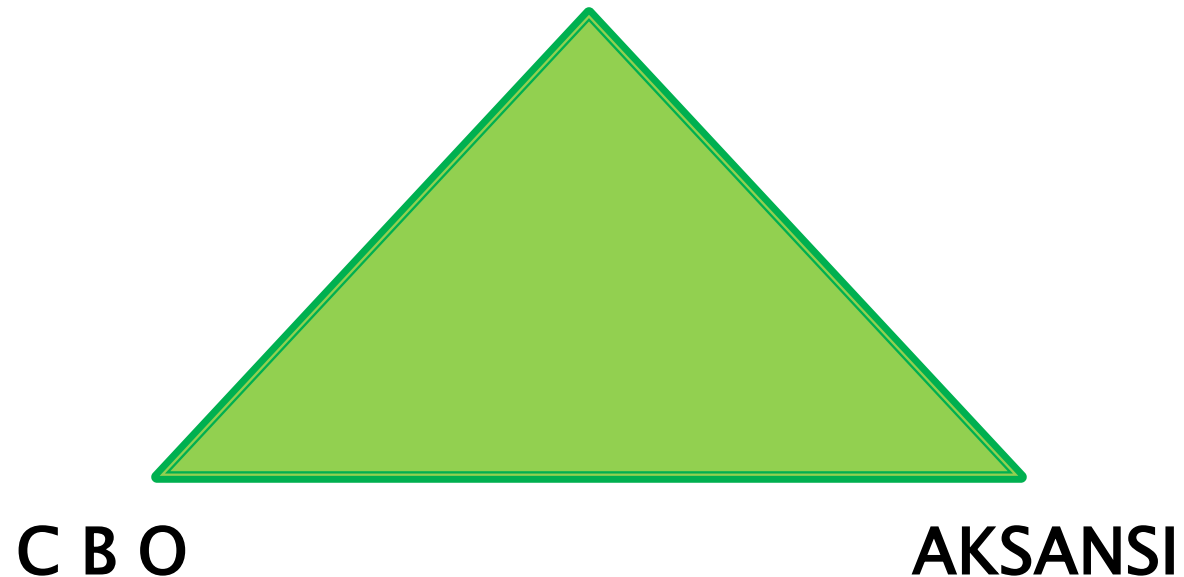


CBS system and connection to Local Government

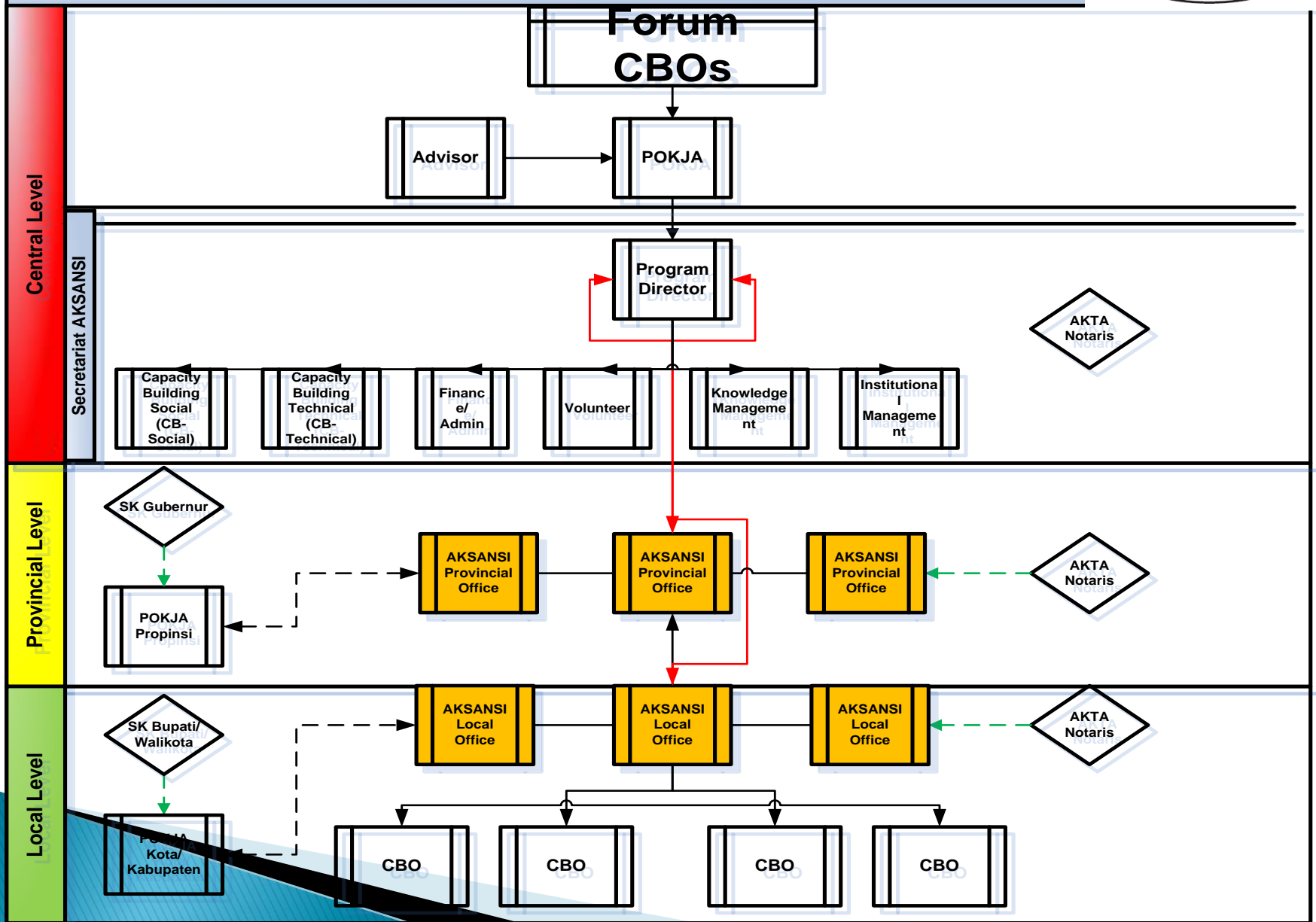




Why *AKSANSI*?

- ▶ *AKSANSI* is an association of CBO sanitation. Established in 2006 by the CBOs forum.
- ▶ *AKSANSI* as the umbrella organization which accommodates the needs of CBO in order to maintain a sustainable operation of the system.
- ▶ A bottom up organization to linkage CBO to the government.
- ▶ *AKSANSI* accommodate CBO to maintain the facilities both in technical and social aspect with various activities.

Advantage AKSANSI

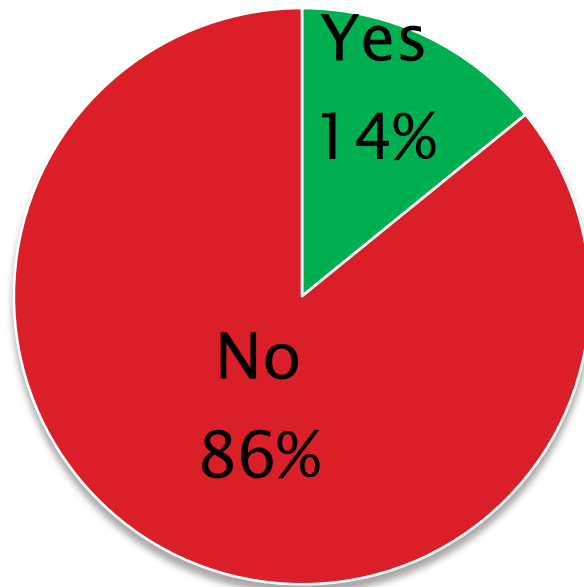


- ▶ Empowering population of dense urban areas and beneficiaries of CBS to manage sanitation facilities in a sustainable way
- ▶ AKSANSI is responsible to coordinate, support and increase the capacity of the CBO
- ▶ Communicating with CBOs and bridging CBO needs with local governments in case of further need for assistance
- ▶ Provide support/consultancy for CBOs on technical, institutional and financial management issues

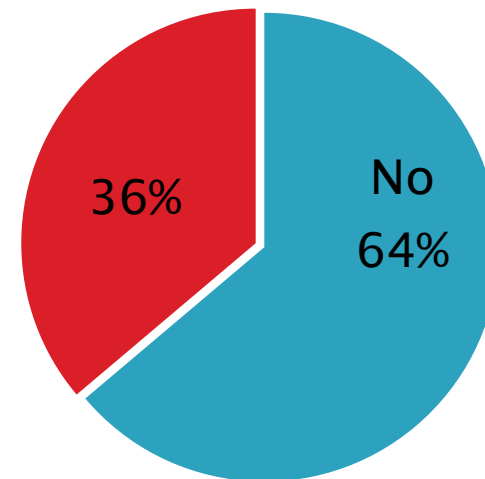

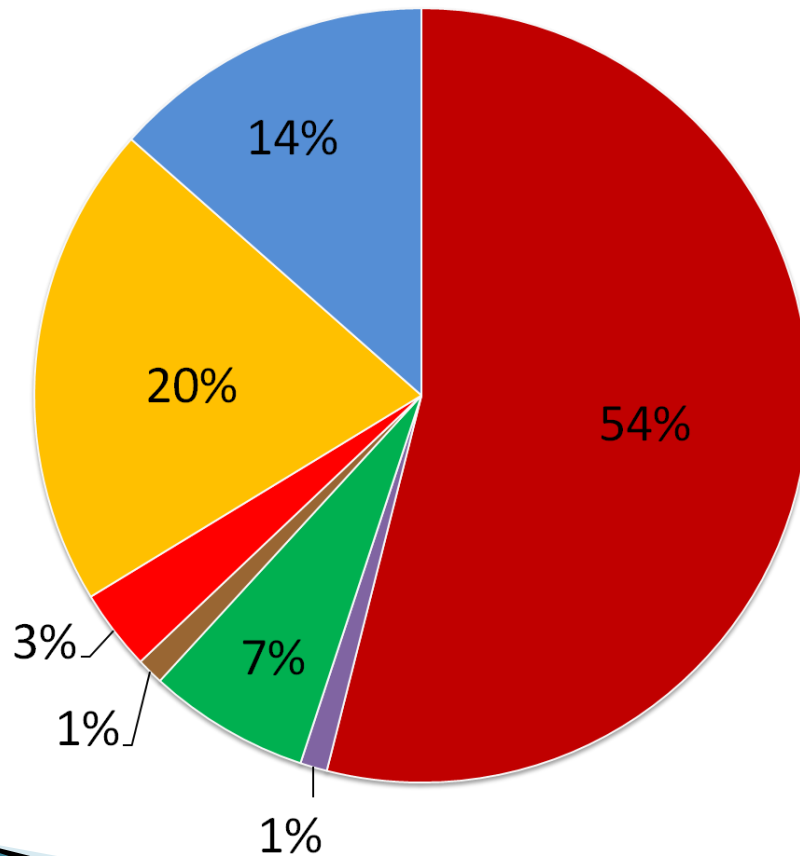

Reason for decreasing user number



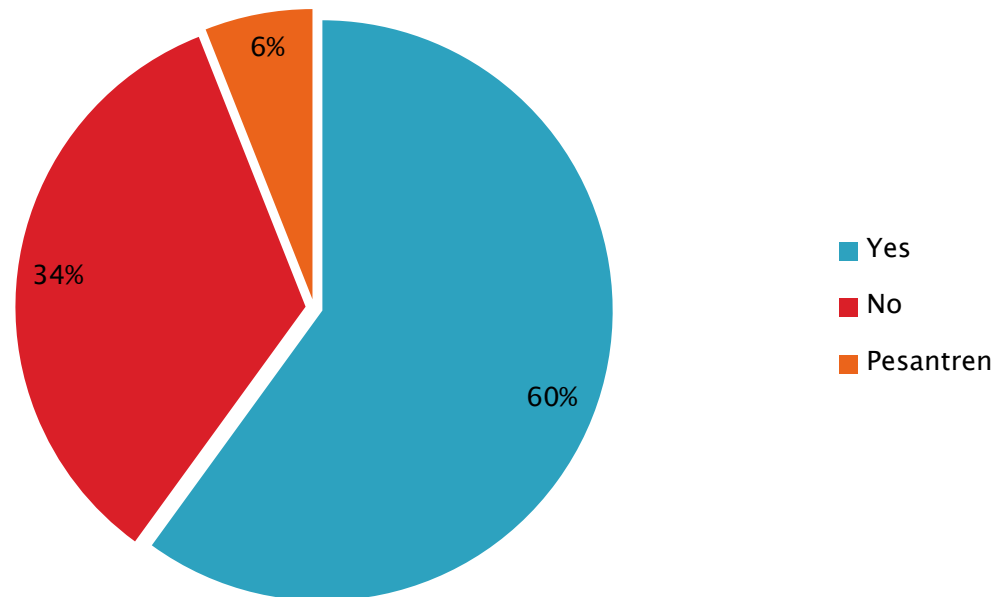
- Toilet are being installed inside household

- ▶ Working with more than 400 existing CBO
- ▶ Establishing 3 cities Branch **AKSANSI** in java region

CBO Existence



What *AKSANSI* is doing ?



- ▶ providing a forum for CBO's to communicate with each other and participate in the ongoing sanitation planning process on local and national level
- ▶ Implement a regular pre-monitoring and monitoring of CBO's
- ▶ Training new CBO's on Biogas and O/M
- ▶ Approaching Local Government to conduct Sanitation/AKSANSI Award for recognizing well maintained CBOs
- ▶ Developing co-financing schemes for upcoming Branches of AKSANSI
- ▶ Updating and providing database on CBS sanitation facilities

Co Management

- ▶ Based on recommendation by WSP and its own findings *AKSANSI* develops linkage and adaptive Co-management with Central, Province, and Local Governments for strengthening of CBO's capacity, knowledge transfer, and assisting CBOs sanitation maintenance
- ▶ Local governments are encouraged to provide necessary operational support for components which are beyond the capacity of low income urban beneficiaries

Result



- ▶ More than 22 biogas taskforce have been trained during 2011 – 2012. 77 cases of minor corrective actions concerning the biogas system were completed.
- ▶ More than 90 member of **AKSANSI** were participating in technical OM refreshment training conducted in cooperation with Universities and the Government
- ▶ More than 125 completed pre-monitoring forms received from CBO's
- ▶ More than 350 monitoring conducted as a joined activity with BORDA and WSP.

Action Plans



- ▶ Providing Call center services for complain mechanism
- ▶ Functioning Knowledge Management for documentation, reporting and communication is developed and applied
- ▶ Provide documentations and reports to project decision makers on time.
- ▶ Develop and implement national capacity building activities jointly.
- ▶ Pre-money DEWATS for 400 locations
- ▶ To conduct AKSANSI Award for 7 cities.
