- *“To establish, review, update and adopt **national sanitation and hygiene policies**... to establish one **national plan** ... and ... ensure national sanitation programs are on track”*
(Commitment 3).

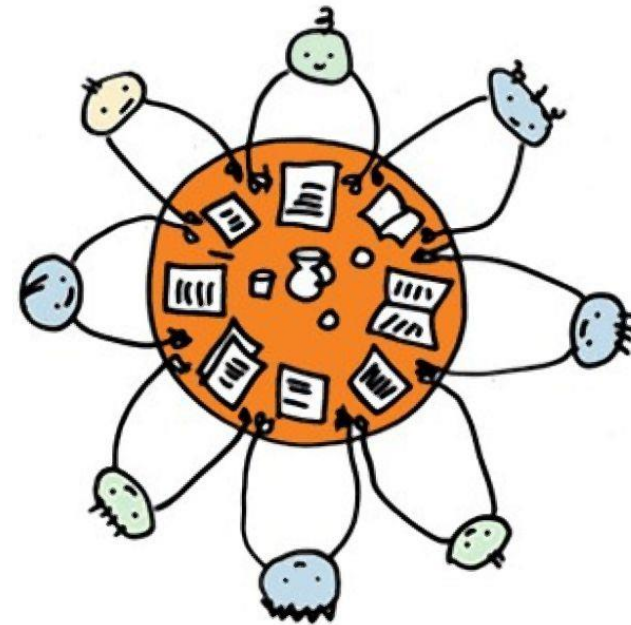
