Experts to find out ways for cleaner sanitation

Four-day world toilet summit to kickstart in the Capital from October 31

EALTH and sanitation experts from 40 countries are expected to deliberate ways to provide clean and appropriate toilets to the public at the eighth World Toilet Summit to be held in Delhi.

The four-day summit—organised jointly by Sulabh International and the World Toilet Organisation—will be flagged off by former President APJ Abdul Kalam on October 31.

The World Toilet Organisation was established in 2000 and aims at discussing and sharing sanitation technology, especially for the devel-

oping world.

"Countries use different techniques of sanitation and we are looking forward to sharing our experiences at the summit. We are also looking at exchanging new ecofriendly ideas and techniques," said Dr.Bindeshwar Pathak, founder, Sulabh International.

Building a toilet is like "setting a new culture", says Pathak. "Sulabh has been a pioneer in the field of sanitation. We have set up toilet blocks in Afghanistan and some African countries. In India, we have tried hard to do away with toilet scavenging and untouchability by setting up clean toilets," says Pathak.


In India, about half-a-million peo-

ple are engaged in scavenging toilets. As part of the idea to do away with untouchability against scavengers, MPs will walk the ramp with children of scavengers at the inaugural function, officials said.

An estimated 2.6 billion people have no access to proper toilets, according to the World Health Organisation. Asia alone has 955 million people without access to toilets, with more than half of these in India and China.

Among the United Nations' Millennium Development Goals, as agreed by its member states, is to halve the number of people without access to safe drinking water by 2015.

The WTO will also strive to

achieve the Millennium Development Goal on water and sanitation by 2015 and provide toilets for all.








Distribution of world GDP, 1989 (percent of total, with quintiles of population ranked by income)














PRE-FAB TOILET TRIANGLE DESIGN




